Dear Madam/Sir

The Festival will take place from 3rd to the 12th of August, 2018 in Niš, Serbia with the first 4 days (3-7.08) reserved for the Theater program and the last 4 days (8-12.08) featuring the Jazz portion. Niš, the second biggest city in Serbia, also known as an industrial city, opens "city doors" for culture in the beginning of August and during the 10 days Niš becomes the cultural city of Europe.

Nisville Jazz Festival is one of the best Jazz Festivals in Europe today with a 25-year long tradition. The UK Guardian placed it in the "top 10 in Europe", and the local media names it "the best from Serbia". In 2017 the Nisville Theater festival featured theatre performances from Italy, Hungary, US, Norway, Bulgaria and Serbia. For 2018 we are working on bringing artist from France, China, Russia, Montenegro, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia and more. This is where we need your support to also feature a theatre from your country.

For 2018 we would like to have theatre performances from Your country in any form that have a strong influence and incorporation of music in the full or part of the performance. They can be combination of contemporary or traditional expression that uses music in any form like performances with live or recorded music in form of drama, comedy, musical, concert-performance, dance, visual art performance.

Since the festival takes place during the lovely European summer season, all performances will be set outdoors. Just like this year we expect the city and audience to be full of local and international guests, visitors and theatre supporters.

In addition to the theatre, film and jazz concerts our festival program also includes expert presentations and demonstrations, lectures and workshops and if some of your artists are interested to conduct workshops we would be delighted for that, too.

Festival will cover all local expenses such as transportations, hotels and food.

Please let us know if you have any representatives that you would like to present their work and your country at Nisville. We are open to your suggestions for the best troupes and artists to take this role. I look forward to hearing back from you and finding the best possible way for performances to be represented at International Nisville Jazz THEATER Festival 2018.
